Join your fellow KSU Retirees October 30, at 10:30 a.m. for a campus tour followed by lunch in the new Commons Dining Facility. Relax on the bus and enjoy a drive through campus and KSU's newly acquired acreage soon to become the Owls Sports Park off Busbee Parkway. After touring, the bus will take us to The Commons for lunch. This new dining hall opened Fall Semester and provides over 50,000 square feet, 1,200 seats and a wide variety of food options including: a bakery, European coffee bar, deli, locally-grown produce, Italian dishes, wok stations for Asian-inspired meals, handmade milkshakes, Southern "comfort" food and more. After lunch, a Human Resources Benefits Specialist will be available for retiree questions about Open Enrollment, which is Oct. 26-Nov. 20 this year.



The all-you-can-eat meal (plus beverage) and tour is just \$10! To participate, please bring cash and meet in the Town Point parking lot. (Town Point is the 4-story KSU building located behind the Spring Hill Suites Hotel, which is across Chastain Road from the main entrance to campus.) The Owl Bus will leave promptly at 10:45. We expect to be back to Town Point at our vehicles between 12:30 and 1 p.m. **(An RSVP for this event is required no later than October 23rd. Meals must be paid with CASH ONLY, so please bring \$10 on event day. To RSVP, email retirees@kennesaw.edu or leave a message on the RSVP line 770-420-4309.)**
